Summary of Discussion in the review meeting held for the implementation of Web based GIS for PMGSY at NRRDA, on 7.12.2017-reg.

A review meeting to assess the current status of the Implementation of GIS for PMGSY was he ld under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary (RC)/DG, NRRDA on 7th December, 2017 in the Conference Hall, NRRDA, New Delhi. Director (RC), Director (Tech.), GIS team from CDAC were present in the meeting. Representatives from the state of Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Jammu & Kashmir, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Punjab, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal were also present in the meeting. The list of participants is attached.

2) Joint Secretary (RC) outlined the importance of the meeting with reference to both the implementation of GIS and as well as the PMGSY as a whole. JS(RC) also emphasised that the status of implementation of GIS is being monitored by both PMO and Niti Aayog. MoRD has a clear mandate of completing and launching the Web GIS of all the states, in phases, before March 2018. JS (RC) further reminded the States that the completion of GIS will be considered as one of the parameters for financial incentives to the states for the year 2017-18. It was further informed that MoRD/NRRDA has proposed to hold a soft launch of the Web GIS of the States, which are ready with their State data on 15.12.2017 in Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi. JS (RC) requested all the States to quickly submit the data to CDAC so that more number of States can participate in the soft launch. The States were also requested to provide a realistic completion plan considering the importance of the project and the target set by the Ministry.

- 4). It was decided that 10 States viz. Karnataka, Telangana, Chhattisgarh, Meghalaya, Odisha, Uttarakhand, Madhya Pradesh, Haryana, Sikkim, Himachal Pradesh would participate in the soft launch scheduled on 15th December 2017. CDAC should check their preparedness and to ensure the same.
- 5) The states of Bihar and Nagaland were not present in the meeting; however, these two states shall adhere to the timeline of January and December respectively for completion of the GIS project.
- 6) The Joint Secretary (RC) concluded the meeting by informing that the states are required to accord top priority for the GIS project. The States should focus now on the completion of the project and for this purpose states should address issues then and there and should not allow them to impede the progress of the GIS work. CDAC to organise orientation training to the states of Jammu & Kashmir, Assam and Uttar Pradesh where new GIS consultants are being fixed. CDAC shall also deploy manpower as already discussed on 30.11.2017 and a proposal shall also be sent to NRRDA.
