Subject: Release of Financial Incentive under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana to the State of Madhya Pradesh (PMGSY) for the year 2022-23.


Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to the payment of Grants-in-aid amounting to Rs.100,14,00,000/- (Rupees One Hundred crore and Fourteen Lakh only) to the State of Madhya Pradesh for "Financial Incentive" as Central assistance under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) for the Financial Year 2022-23.

- 2. These funds are exclusively meant for periodic maintenance of roads already constructed under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana.
- 3. The State Government shall transfer these funds along with the corresponding State share of Rs. 66.76 crore to Madhya Pradesh Rural Road Development Authority (MPRRDA) within a maximum period of 30 days from the date of receipt of these funds. In case of delay beyond 30 days in transfer of central share to the SNA account, interest will be charged at the rate of 7% per annum w.e.f. 01.04.2023. In case of non-transfer beyond this period, Central Government may be constrained to stop further releases. The State Government is required to endorse a copy of the release order to the Government of India at the following address:

- 4. Madhya Pradesh Rural Roads Development Authority (MPRRDA) has nominated Ms. Tanvi Sundriyal, Chief Executive Officer, MPRRDA as the Empowered Officer.
- 5. The funds transferred by the State Government to MPRRDA shall be kept in a separate Saving Bank Account No. 1793139758 in Central Bank of India (IFSC Code-CBIN0283312), 9 Arera Hills Branch, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh. It shall be ensured by Madhya pradesh Rural Roads Development Authority (MPRRDA) that the Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) in the districts have ready access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are allowed to be utilized only by the Executing Agency/Agencies only for the purpose of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana. The Empowered Officer of the Madhya Pradesh Rural Roads Development Authority (MPRRDA) shall communicate to the Bank, the names of the Authorised Signatories, who will be issuing cheques on the Agency's Bank account for the purpose of this sanction.
- 6. The Empowered Officer shall issue standing instructions to the Bank regarding the names of Authorized Payees and their designated account details and the amounts admissible to each payee. He will also specify limits on monthly payments as per the agreed work programme for the respective package.



- 7. No Utilization Certificate is pending from Madhya Pradesh Rural Roads Development Authority (MPRRDA)
- 8. The Utilization Certificate should be submitted within 12 (Twelve) months of the closure of Financial Year which shall include interest accrued. Interest accrued should be computed based on the details of the Ledger Account maintained for the purpose
- 9. The State Nodal Agency shall ensure that the interest earned from the funds released should be mandatorily remitted to the respective Consolidated Funds on pro-rata basis in term of **Rule 230(8) of GFR, 2017.** Interest earned should be clearly and separately depicted in PFMS, scheme-specific portals integrated with PFMS and in MIS provided by the banks.
- 10. The State Government shall ensure the integration of the state treasury with PFMS and all the entries should be reflected on PFMS.
- 11. The State Nodal Agency shall ensure that sufficient budget provisions are made in the state budget before the request of further funds release.
- 12. The Accounts of the grantee institution will be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the internal Audit of the O/o the CCA of the Ministry of Rural Development in terms of Rule 236(1) of the General Financial Rules.
- 13. The expenditure is debitable to the following Head of Accounts under **Demand No. 87** Department of Rural Development (2022-23):
