Subject: Release of Rs 8.4325 Crore to State Government of Odisha as 1st Tranche of 1st installment of Programme Fund to the State Government of Odisha under Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM-JANMAN) for the year 2023-24 – reg.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to the payment of Grants-in-aid amounting to **Rs. 8,43,25,000/- (Rupees Eight Crore Forty Three Lakh and Twenty Five Thousand only)** to the State Government of Odisha as 1st Tranche of 1st installment of Central assistance under **Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM-JANMAN)** Programme Fund for the **Financial Year 2023-24**.

2. The amount of Rs. 8.4325 crore released in the present sanction is adjusted as per the details given below:

3. State may come for the next release subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- Opening of State Linked Scheme (SLS) for PM-JANMAN and map it with PFMS, as exemption is allowed only on releasing funds till finalization of separate SLS and budget line.
- Opening of separate budget lines and their mapping in PFMS be completed on priority.
- Opening of a separate bank account for PM-JANMAN and to be marked as SNA of the scheme.
- The same Nodal agency can be used/kept for both the schemes i.e., PMGSY and PM-JANMAN.
- A separate bank account for PM JANMAN may be opened in the same bank where the SNA of the PMGSY exists.
- Funds utilized for the purpose will be recouped in the account of PMGSY from the funds made available for PM-JANMAN through transfer entry later on.

3. The State Government shall transfer these funds along with the corresponding State Share to Odisha State Rural Road Agency (OSRRA) within a maximum period of 30 days from the date of receipt of these funds. In case of delay beyond 30 days in transfer of Central Share to the SNA account, interest will be charged at the rate of 7% per annum. The State Government is required to endorse a copy of the release order to the Government of India at the following address:

4. Odisha State Rural Road Agency (OSRRA) has nominated Sri Prasanna Kumar Sahoo, Chief Engineer (PMGSY) as the Empowered Officer of Odisha State Rural Road Agency (OSRRA).

5. The funds transferred by the State Government to OSRRA shall be kept in a separate saving Bank Account No. 10872161766 (IFS Code: SBIN0000041) in State Bank of India, Bhubaneswar Main Branch, District Khurda, Odisha –751009. It shall be ensured by Odisha State Rural Road Agency (OSRRA) that the Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) in the districts have ready access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are allowed to be utilized only by the Executing Agency/Agencies only for the purpose of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana. The Empowered Officer of the Odisha State Rural Road Agency (OSRRA) shall communicate to the Bank, the names of the Authorised Signatories, who will be issuing cheques on the Agency's Bank account for the purpose of this sanction.

6. The Empowered Officer shall issue standing instructions to the Bank regarding the names of Authorized Payees and their designated account details and the amounts admissible to each payee. He will also specify limits on monthly payments as per the agreed work programme for the respective package.

7. No Utilization Certificate is pending from Odisha State Rural Road Agency (OSRRA).

8. The Utilization Certificate should be submitted within 12 (Twelve) months of the closure of Financial Year which shall include interest accrued. Interest accrued should be computed based on the details of the Ledger Account maintained for the purpose.

9. The State Nodal Agency shall ensure that the interest earned from the funds released should be mandatorily remitted to the respective Consolidated Funds on pro-rata basis in term of Rule 230(8) of GFR, 2017. Interest earned should be clearly and separately depicted in PFMS, scheme- specific portals integrated with PFMS and in MIS provided by the banks.

10. The State Government shall ensure the integration of the state treasury with PFMS and all the entries should be reflected on PFMS.

11. The State Nodal Agency shall ensure that sufficient budget provisions are made in the state budget before the request of further funds release.

12. The accounts of the grantee institutions will be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Internal Audit of the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry in terms of Rule 236(1) of the General Financial Rules.

13. The expenditure is debitable to the following Head of Accounts under **Demand No. 87** Department of Rural Development (2023-24):
