I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the payment of Grants-in-aid amounting to Rs. 185,00,00,000/- (Rupees One Hundred and Eighty Five Crore only) to the State Government of Uttarakhand as Central assistance under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) for the Financial Year 2023-24 as per the details given below:-

2. The above said sanction of **Rs. 181.05 crore** is being adjusted under **Regular PMGSY** as per the details given below:

The State Government shall transfer these funds along with the corresponding State share to Uttarakhand Rural Roads Development Agency (URRDA) within a maximum period of 30 days from the date of receipt of these funds. In case of delay beyond 30 days in transfer of Central Share to the SNA account, interest will be charged at the rate of 7% per annum. The State Government is required to endorse a copy of the release order to the Government of India at the following address:

- 4. Uttarakhand Rural Roads Development Agency (URRDA), Dehradun has nominated **Shri Uday Raj Singh**, **Chief Executive Officer**, Uttarakhand Rural Roads Development Agency (URRDA) as the Empowered Officer.
- 5. The funds transferred by the State Government to URRDA shall be kept in a separate Saving Bank Account No.30256973236 (IFS Code-SBIN0005713, Branch Code-05713) in State Bank of India, First Floor, Vindlas Complex, Rajpur Road, Dehradun. Implementing Agencies (IAs) down the ladder should use the SNA's account with clearly defined drawing limits set for that account. It shall be ensured by the State Government that the Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) in the districts have ready access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are allowed to be utilized only by the Executing Agency/Agencies only for the purpose of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana as per the limit assigned. The Empowered Officer of the Uttarakhand Rural Roads Development Agency (URRDA) shall communicate to the Bank, the names of the Authorised Signatories, who will be issuing cheques on the Agency's Bank account for the purpose of this sanction.
- 6. The Empowered officer shall issue standing instructions to the Bank regarding the names of Authorised Payees and their designated account details and the amounts admissible to each payee. He will also specify limits on monthly payment as per the agreed work programme for the respective package.
- 7. No Utilization Certificate is pending from **Uttarakhand Rural Roads Development Agency (URRDA)**, **Dehradun**.
- 8. The State Nodal Agency shall ensure that the interest earned from the funds released should be mandatorily remitted to the respective Consolidated Funds on pro-rata basis in term of **Rule 230(8)** of GFR, 2017. Interest earned should be clearly and separately depicted in PFMS, scheme-specific portals integrated with PFMS and in MIS provided by the banks.
- 9. The State Government shall ensure the integration of the state treasury with PFMS and all the entries should be reflected on PFMS.
- 10. The State Nodal Agency shall ensure that sufficient budget provisions are made in the state budget before the request of further funds release.
- 11. The Utilization Certificate should be submitted within 12 (Twelve) months of the closure of Financial Year which shall include interest accrued. Interest accrued should be computed based on the details of the Ledger Account maintained for the purpose.
- 12. The accounts of the grantee institutions will be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Internal Audit of the O/o the CCA, Ministry of Rural Development in terms of **Rule 236 (1)** of the General Financial Rules.
- 13. The expenditure is debitable to the following Head of Accounts under **Demand No. 87** Department of Rural Development (2023-24):

- Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major Head).
